Musa Darboe, born in Bansang, The Gambia, spent 15 years working on his family's rice farm, gaining deep insight into the local rice industry.

After earning a BS from Southern Polytechnic University, he worked as a Network Engineer at Verizon Wireless in the U.S.

Driven by a passion to transform Gambia's rice sector, he founded Maruo Farms in 2018 to modernize rice production, reduce imports, and create jobs.

In December 2018, he returned home to implement his vision. Today, Maruo Farms cultivates 128 hectares and supports over 6,000 outgrowers, making it a leader in mechanized rice farming in The Gambia.

Overview of Rice Production in The Gambia







- A population of 2.6 Million
- 75% of the workforce in agriculture; rice is a staple
- Per capita rice consumption = 117 kilograms per year
- Local production meets only ~16% of national demand
- Heavy reliance on imports (e.g., \$73 million spent in 2024

Work with WFP Gambia







WFP supported Maruo with:

- Blender for rice fortification;
- Trained personnel of Food Safety and QualityMarket linkage with 422 schools
- Since 2021, Maruo Farms continues to provide rice including **fortified rice** to over 100,000 children in 422 local primary schools for school meals annually.
- In 2023, Maruo provide 489MT of Rice and 108MT of rice for general food assistance to 3,333 flood affected population.
