



#### WFP SUPPORT FOR 2021 FLOOD RESPONSE

- Direct logistics and logistics coordination support
- transported a total of 469MT of relief cargo
- Chartered flights to conduct rapid impact assessments across the country
- Supported the receipt and transport of donations
- Provided IT equipment to emergency internet capacity
- the CPA emergency food basket, and provided USD 20 000 in cash to procure emergency food items











### **Challenges:**

Inter-ministerial coordination, including roles and responsibilities of different ministries in emergency response

#### Follow up:

 Promulgation of Civil Protection Decree in March 2022.

Its given right to Civil Protection Authority Office to lead coordination when a disaster occur.



- Many if not most sectors do not have dedicated sector coordination capacity

Multi-stake holder seminar in April 2022 to improve coordination between government offices, between UN agencies (sector) and NGOs (international and National)

### Standing Memorandum of Understanding to achieve joint SDG goals in Partnership with WFP



- 1. Provide technical support to the CPA in strengthening emergency response and supply chain / logistics management practices and capacities.
- 2. Strategic policy support where needed in the formation of disaster preparedness and response activities.
- 3. Improving local capacity in the provisioning of emergency cash based assistance.
- 4. Coordinate activities with multiple partners to create continuity in the response.

#### WFP PROVIDES GREAT SUPPORT TO CIVIL PROTECTION

- Continue technical support and guidance in the areas of emergency logistics and response, sectoral coordination and supply chain/logistics management.
- Logistics Augmentation Support where needed, including training of CPA logistics personnel in commodity management practices, currently transfer of 2000mt of donated rice to the CPA from the port to the Government storage facilities, including eventual fortification and onward distribution of this rice.
- Donated 38.5MT of High Energy Biscuits for distribution to disaster victims by the CPA, WFP committed
  to including basic training on the use of HEB and support in its including in the CPA emergency food
  basket and transport/distribution.
- WFP committed to supporting a CPA delegation to Australia as part of the Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (APMCDRR) 2022
